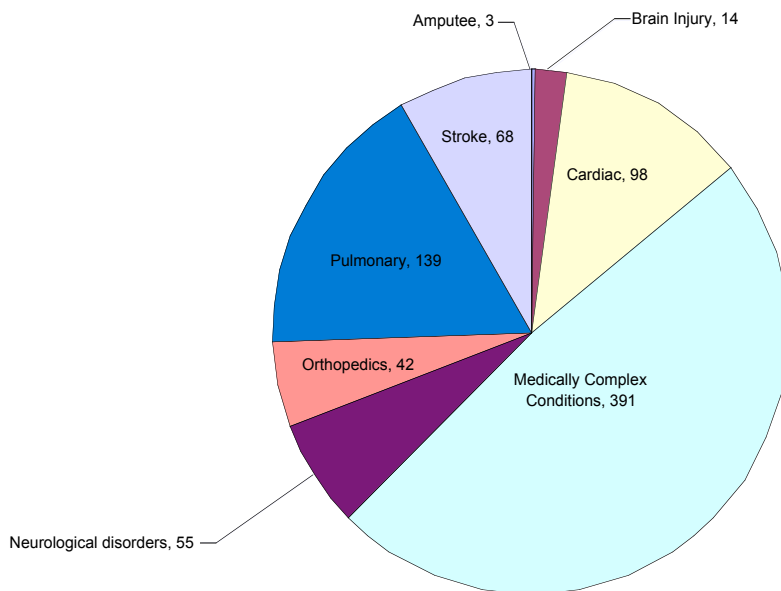


**Comprehensive Integrated Inpatient Rehabilitation Program
Program Evaluation Report
January 2009 – December 2009**



Average Age: 70

Gender: 54% Males; 46% Females

Average LOS: 26 Days

Amount of Therapy: Rehab services up to 3 hours per day based on the patient's ability to participate

Disposition at Discharge:

- 63% Discharged Home
- 24% Discharged to Long Term Facilities or Nursing Homes
- 10% Discharged to an Acute Care Hospital

Outcomes: 63% of patients discharged from the Program returned home as compared to 65% of the Nation

Ventilator Rehabilitation Population:

- 100 Discharges
- 71% of all ventilator patients were weaned
- 48% of weaned patients returned to the community

Patient Satisfaction Survey Findings:

“Overall care at the hospital”, 90% answered good/very good.

“Likelihood of recommending facility”, 90% answered good/very good.
